Dear Friends of New Horizon,

In that light, consider Psalm 89:15-16, “*Blessed are those who have learned to acclaim You, God. They rejoice in Your Name all day long.*”

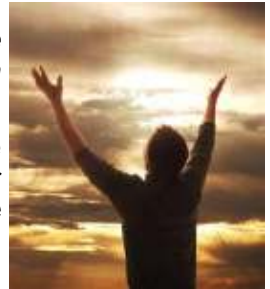
Consider a couple of steps in the process:

Second, *anticipation*. God is alive and busy in our lives. He knows us personally and intimately, and truly acts on our behalf. What’s He up to today? Where’s His hand of blessings? What’s He speaking to my heart? How’s He shaping and molding me today? How’s God using me in someone else’s life? Dialing in and becoming attuned to God’s activity is part of our growing faith. He’s always with us, always working, always. “*Father, help me see Your hand today.*”

Such is the ebb and flow of a Christ-follower. It takes some effort. It calls for some maturing. But, it brings *huge* joy and satisfaction to our God-walk.

That’s what we’re all about at New Horizon—we’re walking, following, and including others along the way. It’s a daily sight-seeing tour, constantly on the lookout for God. And there’s always room for one more. Care to be a part?

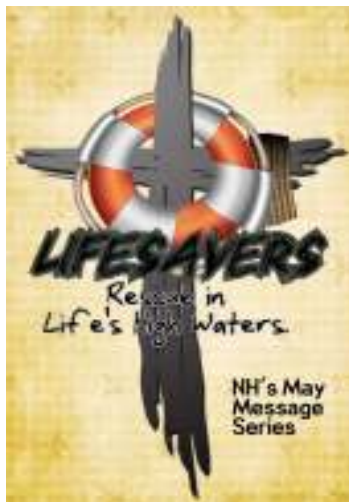

What's a Charge Conference? In United Methodist protocol, certain decisions regarding finances, facilities, staffing, etc., must be approved during a "Charge Conference." A Charge Conference's voting members include NH's Leadership Team (duly elected leaders and officers per the United Methodist Book of Discipline), and our District Superintendent. In addition, all NH members are invited to attend and voice their opinions. An annual Charge Conference is held in the fall of every year to nominate and elect officers, approve our annual budget, etc. A *called* Charge Conference is scheduled mid-year if a need arises. Such a need has occurred. At issue: NH presently rents a home for our Lead Pastor. Our Leadership Team has put forth a proposal that would permit Pastor Mark and Denise to purchase their own home. This proposal requires the action of a Charge Conference. All elected leaders and officers are asked to attend, and any official member of NH may attend and offer comments during the proceedings.

## Applying Bible Principles

Someone once said, "Experience is a good teacher, but she gives the test first and then the lesson." That's certainly true, and based on many of life's experiences, we frequently fail the test before we can benefit from the lesson.

The formula "e equals mc<sup>2</sup>" is familiar to many college students but understood by very few people. Most of us know it had something to do with Einstein and was the formula that led to the release of enormous energy and to the nuclear age. Similarly, in funding the local church, "e" might stand for *every*, "m" for *member*, "c" for *commitment*, and the "2" for the *effort multiplied by itself*. The fruit of that kind of effort is much more powerful than what Einstein discovered, even as Jesus described it in Matthew 21:22 — "If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer."

Right now, as we consider the opportunity to support the ministries here at New Horizon United Methodist Church, God is putting us to the test. As Gordon Moyes stated, "Responsible giving or stewardship is not man's way of raising money, but God's way of raising people. . . . The church's budget is not a list of its expenses, but a record of its vision. It is not a list of bills to be met, but a program of ministry to be achieved."

As each of us prayerfully considers what God would have us give, and as we obey what God asks of us, we can trust Him to provide the resources. That's a test — a test of where we are spiritually much more than where we are financially. It's a test of us as individuals and of us as a church. The question is whether or not we really believe that God has the power and ability to bless our obedience "more than all we ask or imagine" (Eph. 3:20).

How are you doing concerning God's tests regarding money in your life? If God's provision in your life in the days ahead depends on *how* you obey His leading *now* concerning your giving, what will the future be like for you?

It just might, you know. . . .



